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FRESH RENDERINGS OF STARCHITECT TADAO ANDO'S NYC DEBUT

New renderings of Pritzker Prize-winning architect Tadao Ando's first standalone building in New York City – a seven-story, seven-unit building at 152 Elizabeth Street in Nolita – are here.

In December, The Real Deal reported that Saif Sumaida and Amit Khurana purchased the site for \$21 million in March 2014 and tapped Ando to design the building

The building will house bespoke apartments measuring from 1,900 square feet to more than 5,600 square feet. Half-floor residences will start at \$5.9 million while full-floor condos will start at \$15 million. The penthouse will ask more than \$35 million, according Curbed.
